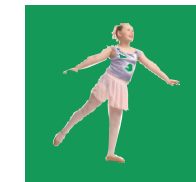
### Musical Feet provides two choices in dance education:

**Our History:** Beginning in the 1970s as a School of Tap and gradually expanding to embrace a full array of dance forms, Musical Feet has produced annual student concerts in the Hult Center for the Performing Arts since the theater's opening in 1984. The School has become known for its entertaining concerts and cutting-edge tap dance training and choreography. The student tap company has traveled to several competitions and international tap festivals where they have connected with youth companies from various U.S. cities and studied with and performed for many of

the great tap masters of our time.

### The Tap Program

Musical Feet has earned a reputation as the leading tap school in the area. Director Jeanette Frame founded the school more than 30 years ago with a desire to contribute to the Tap Renaissance, which was just beginning after its 30-year hiatus from the entertainment scene. She brings a wealth of personal tap training that ranges from the 1940s to the present, and she has developed a training curriculum that gives tap dancers a strong foundation of the steps and styles of the 1920s through 40s and progressing to the exciting jazz rhythm tap styles of today. In recent decades, Frame enjoys national recognition as a tap dance performer and choreographer. She remains connected with leading international tap dance artists – both to study with them and as a colleague/guest teacher herself in some of the international tap festivals that are held in various U.S. locations.



Our hip hop, jazz, and ballet instructors also contribute a wealth of training and performance experience and provide essential conditioning and skill-building exercises to ensure dancers use proper body mechanics as they learn new moves. The hip hop program ranges from interpretations of stylized funky jazz dance to pop-lock, wave, boogaloo, and robotics. Musical theater, bellydance, salsa, and ballroom classes round out our dance menu.

### Performing Companies



The tap and hip hop performing companies exist to give the dancers more performance opportunities and to share the joys, intricacies, and artistry of their dance forms with the community at large. The companies perform in several area concerts, fairs, and festivals, and they do their own show once per season in a local theater. Auditions for

the companies are held each season in the summer and the fall.
